Rabbi Maralee Gordon is a life-long resident of the Chicago area. She was ordained by the Academy for Jewish Religion in 2001, after an earlier career in Jewish Education. She has served Congregation Beth Shalom of DeKalb and McHenry County Jewish Congregation, and retired from the pulpit to be able to spend more time with her children and grandchildren, who reside in Menlo Park, Ca., Melbourne, Australia, and Ramat Gan, Israel. She and her husband, Leo Schlosberg, have lived in Woodstock, IL, for 30 years. She is a member of the pastoral care group of the Interfaith Committee for Detained Immigrants, and serves on the boards of FaithBridge Interfaith Consortium of Northern Illinois and the Greater Carolina Association of Rabbis. We are pleased to welcome Rabbi Gordon back to Central Synagogue.

Hazzan Toby Lou Hayman is the Spiritual Leader of Central Synagogue, where she conducts Shabbat and holiday services and provides pastoral services to congregants in times of joy and sorrow. She is a dedicated teacher of Torah, Nusach, and biblical, prayer and conversational Hebrew. She is a graduate of the Jewish Theological Seminary and the University of Chicago. Hazzan Hayman has the distinction of being the first woman Hazzan to serve a Chicago area Conservative congregation. She has earned a Certificate in Spiritual Direction from the Yedidya Center for Jewish Spiritual Direction, and she offers group and individual spiritual direction, guidance, and companionship as a Spiritual Director.
